

the story behind sunset vets

The Sunset Vets story starts with a simple question:

"If we could rethink the way end of life medicine is delivered... how might that ease the burden for patients and families in our care..."

Sunset Vets grew from humble beginnings; it started with one veterinarian's desire to rethink the way she cared for patients at the end of life. Taking her cue from the human model of palliative care, Sunset Vets founder, Dr Jackie Campbell, recognised that a specialised service focusing on client support was desperately needed in the veterinary industry. She understood that palliative care and end of life discussions were challenging for both veterinarians and owners in the clinic setting, and that for busy practices, offering compassionate in-home euthanasia at the exact time it is needed, was often difficult.

What started as a labour of love alongside her clinical job quickly grew and in 2015, Dr Jackie left her role in general practice to devote herself to providing full-time end of life care for pets in need. Since this time, Sunset Vets has grown from a one-person initiative to a compassionate company consisting of a team of dedicated mobile veterinarians, office and client support staff and the services of both a qualified counsellor and psychologist specialising in animal bereavement.

Caring for a pet that is struggling or terminally ill can be distressing and many clients want to know what else can be done to make their pets more comfortable. They often also require ongoing emotional support. The Sunset Home Veterinary Care team are passionate about providing this specialised care for pets and their families from the comfort of home.

Our veterinarians work one on one with clients whose pets are in the end stages of life.


Our focus is on providing specialised palliative advice, the formulation of pain management plans and assisting with symptom control.

Our team are available to assist with compassionate in-home euthanasia 7 days a week by appointment.


We can assist clients and clinics with aftercare arrangements, counselling and professional grief support.




CYNTHIA BURNETT - GYPSY


HOW WE WORK WITH YOU
